

Named after the first president of Czechoslovakia, T.G. Masaryk, and founded in 1919, Masaryk University is the second largest university in Brno, the Czech Republic's second biggest city.

Terms and Conditions for participating in the Medical Doorway Czech Republic Tour

Terms of Reference

- The term "Participant" shall include all representatives any organisation to whom space has been allocated for the purposes of participating in the tour
- · The term "Organiser" means Medical Doorway Limited
- The term "Tour" shall mean the event(s) referred to in the form above including online events and the road show tour
- The term "Contract" means the contract for participation in the tour entered into between the Organiser and the Participant.
- The tour runs from 11th November 16th November 2018
- 1. Breach of Contract and/or withdrawal by Participant(s). If a Participant(s) withdraws from the Tour they must confirm this in writing to the Organiser. The Participant will incur the following charges:
- Cancellation within 60 31 days prior to the start of the tour 50% of full costs payable.
- Cancellation within 30 days prior to the start of the event- Full cost payable.
- 2. Payment and invoicing. Bookings will be invoiced immediately and payment will be due 30 days after the invoice date.
- 3. The Organiser reserves the right to change the itinerary and duration of tour. In the event of change, the agreement to participate shall remain in force so long as the participant is informed at least one week prior to such a change-taking place.

- 4. The Organiser shall not be liable for any loss sustained by the Participant directly or indirectly attributable to cancellation, suspension or reduction of the Tour due to:

- Acts of war, military activity, and municipal statutory or civil authority requisition.
- Fire or excessively inclement weather e.g. earthquake, flood, or typhoon.
- Damage caused by a foreign object including aerial objects or aircraft.

- If the Tour is cancelled, reduced or postponed then in such an event the unit costs paid to the Organiser, or any part there of may be refunded at the sole discretion of the Organiser to the Participants.
